

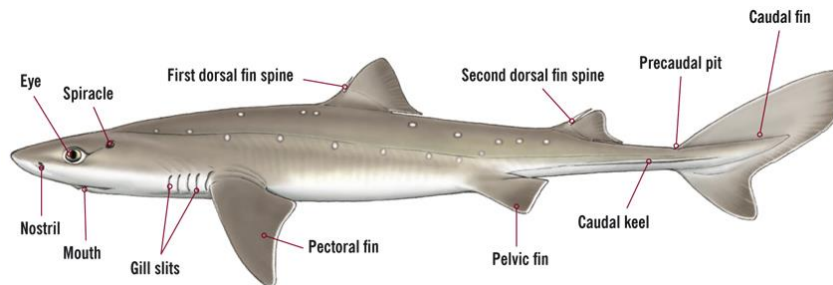
# Science Labs: Dissection
